Fellowship Housing Opportunities to Host an Open House to Celebrate the Opening of New Administrative Offices

Concord, NH – Fellowship Housing Opportunities, Inc. will celebrate the opening of its new administrative offices at 36 Pleasant Street in Concord by hosting an Open House on Tuesday, October 2, from 4:30 to 6:30 pm at the new location.

The Open House is the culmination of over three years of work to acquire the Pleasant Street building. In addition to the new administrative office space, the Pleasant Street Project provides nine housing units for very-low income people with disabilities, as well as program space in the lower level. With this acquisition, Fellowship Housing owns or manages 50 housing units serving 78 adults and seven children, including Fellowship House, a group home that provides transitional housing and 24-hour support to 12 residents; Fellowship Apartments, Washington Court and Fayette Street Project, which were developed in response to the growing need for residents of Fellowship House to transition into independent and affordable community housing; 106 South State Street, an eight-unit Community Development Block Grant project that offers permanent housing to very low-income people with disabilities; 21 Spruce Street, a single-family “Home of Your Own Project” that was developed in conjunction with the NH Community Loan Fund and 10 Jackson Street, purchased through a private “bargain sale.”

Fellowship Housing Opportunities, Inc. is a 501(c)3 organization founded in the 1960’s by a group of citizens concerned about the growing number of people being released from the state mental hospital into homelessness. Fellowship Housing’s purpose is to provide decent, affordable housing and “recovery-oriented” support for adults who have no alternative other than costly hospitalization.
